MIXED USE DEVELOPMENT - CBD

This iconic development on the verges of the CBD combines the best of both worlds.

The lower floors are dedicated to commercial activities oriented round a central atrium. Suited to shop spaces and offices, the location of the development makes it ideal for these functions.

The tower offers residential suites in the format of a residential hotel. At once a home to retreat to and a comfort of luxury and service afforded in a hotel.

Further facilities include restaurants, wellness facilities and rooftop gardens.



Architecturally the development is a dichotomy in statement. A green haven, wrapped round an inner court, and a phallic symbol, standing proud against the skyline.

Delicate curves define both the inside court as well as the residential tower alongside. The harmony in the curves of the void, and the curves of the solid tower are what make this development stand out from any other with the same intention.

Roof spaces provide open terraces for the enjoyment of the residents in recreational activities rooftop gardens



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THE OASIS - Westlands



This proposal for a lifestyle centre in the popular Westlands Shopping Centre was the winning proposal in a limited competition called for by the developer for the adaptive reuse of an iconic building.

Yet to be implemented, The Oasis was named for the inner sanctum created by the design approach. The building was turned inward to create a place of repose and rebirth within the centre of a bustling commercial zone. The entirety is sheathed in a tensile roofing structure that evokes images of the tents pitched by weary travellers as they took refuge in a desert oasis.



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SPA - Naivasha



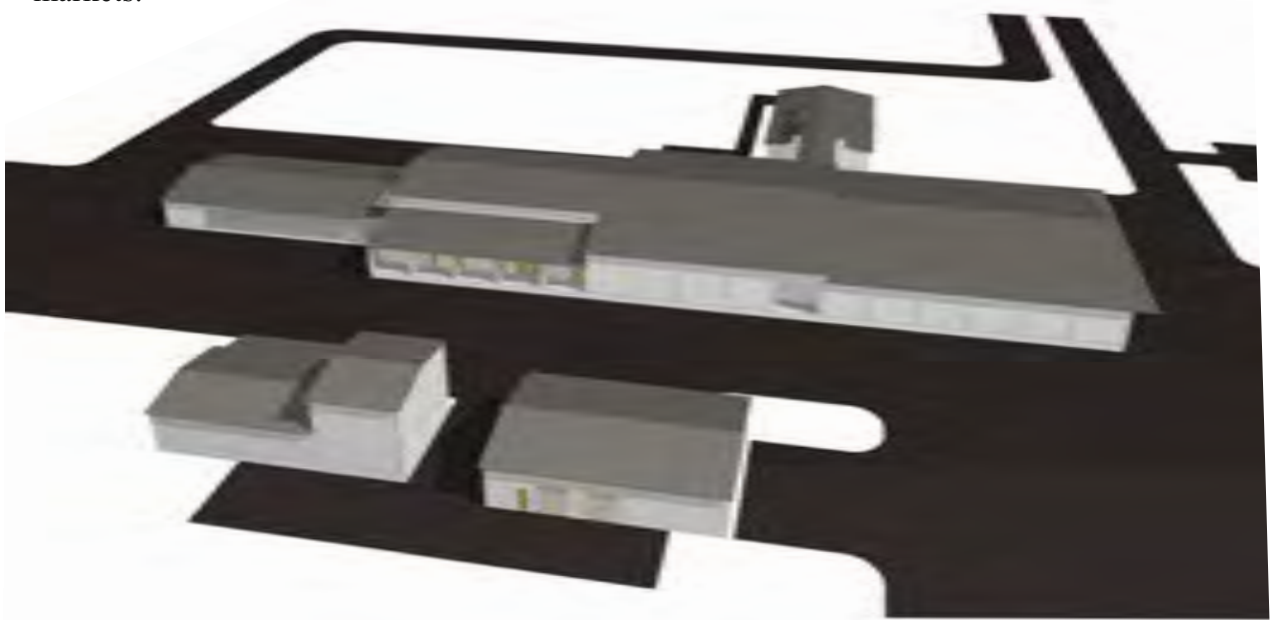

The architecture is designed to be the beginning of this transformation, from the entry over a lake created from a natural feature on site, to the serene internal and external spaces for repose and reflection. The chance to reconnect with the inner self in a truly spellbinding setting is the promise of this creation.



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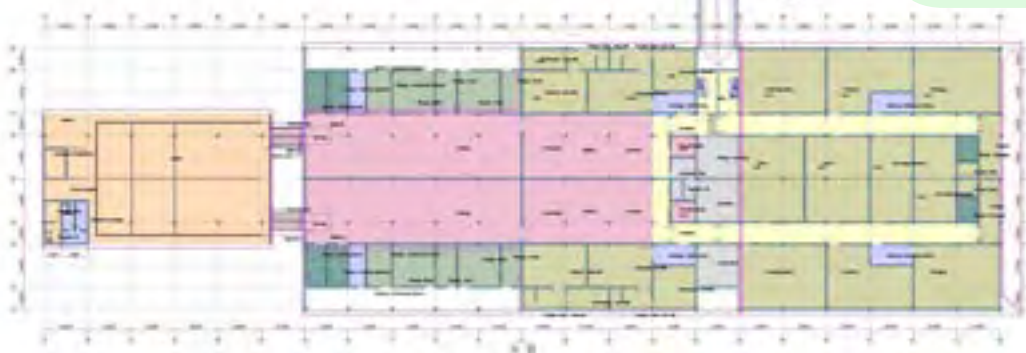
ABBATOIR - Tanzania

The project aimed to create an abattoir capable of slaughtering 10 large animals an hour to HACCP standards, targetting the EU and Middle East markets.



The commission involved close collaboration with the German-based supplier of equipment and the adoption of provided specifications to local standards and building methods.

The brief included Lairage, Slaughterhouse, Processing, Rendering Plant, Workshops and Administrative Units. It also included staff facilities, an electrical sub-station, stores, and ancillary service areas.



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Primetech Industries - Industrial Area

A local manufacturer of motor vehicle accessories, including brake pads, Primetech approached Spectrum Architects to provide technical assistance in relocating their manufacturing to new premises adjoining their current position.

Involving the maximisation of space with a tight programme of machinery to fit, Our input was invaluable in setting up the factory in the very short timeframe required



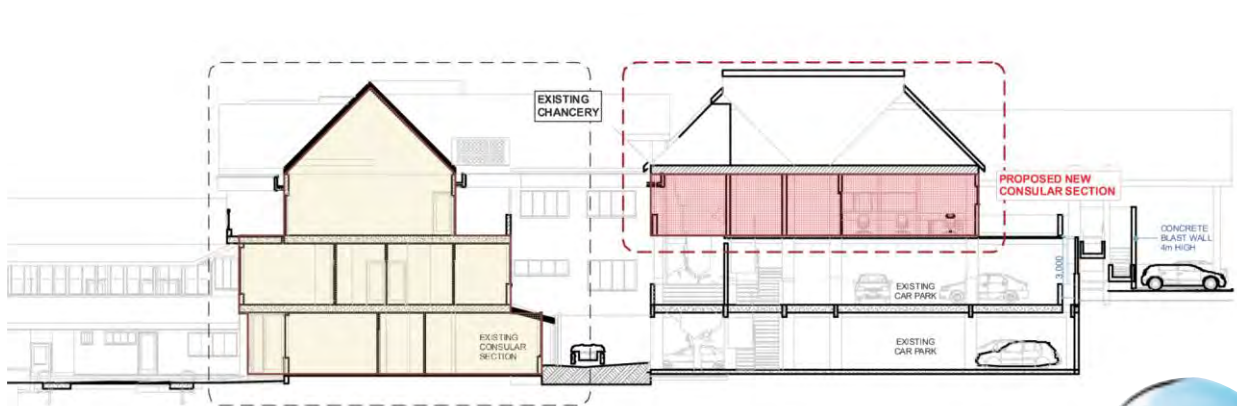
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EMBASSY - Riverside Drive



The brief on this job was an infill development to provide for additional space to an existing embassy facility in Nairobi.

As with all infill developments a level of dexterity was required to fit the proposed additions to the existing both in use and in form while integrating the whole into an appreciable aesthetic statement. Additional parameters were imposed by the security concerns associated with foreign missions.



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APARTMENTS - Kileleshwa

This apartment campus consists of 68 apartments offering three and five bedroom floor plans, with the aim of creating a home in which to raise a family.

In this development you'll discover a truly rare combination: easy, uncomplicated apartment living with the look, feel and comfort of a brand new luxury home.

The apartments are relaxed elegance at its finest. From quiet places for solitude, to spacious living areas perfect for entertaining, to fully equipped amenity centers.



The apartment homes have an “urban” loft feel with cutting-edge designs, high quality finishes and expansive windows. Each building offers excellent views onto manicured landscaped gardens with breathtaking water features. 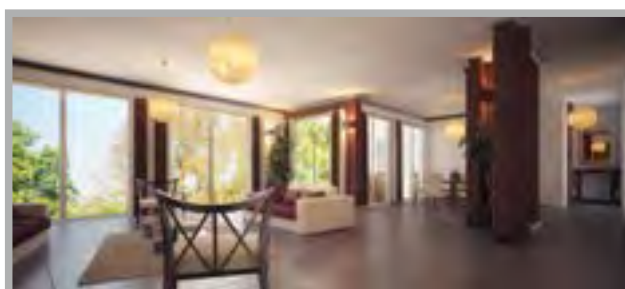
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RIVERSIDE PLACE - Riverside

Double decker parking at the entrance makes maximum use off the natural gradient to tuck away vehicular traffic and ensures direct interaction with greenery by every block.

Offering middle level executive apartments, Kindaville aims to make the most of its river front with a mix of duplex and single level apartments. The curved apartment fronts form a signature look and is applied to the prime spaces of master bedroom and lounge.



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ARBORETUM VIEW - Kileleshwa

On a difficult but beautiful site bordering the Nairobi Arboretum is a mixed use development offering 25 two bedroom units with ancillary facilities that boast some of the greenest view in the vicinity of the City centre.

Located in a prime position the development makes best use of its views to allow the major living spaces visual access to the lush green of the arboretum



Internally, the units are designed with every convenience in mind and are modern in outlook featuring open plan kitchens with fitted units and floor to ceiling windows that maximise the vista.



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GOLDEN PALM -Westlands

Designed from the ground up as a Residential Hotel, Golden Palm offers every convenience of home to the road-weary traveller.

Spacious lounges, generous balconies, open plan kitchens, and en-suite rooms are but the most obvious. Communal facilities include a gym with steam room, business centre, al-fresco fine dining facilities and a roof top terrace. Views from the roof top terrace over the city scape of Westlands, Nairobi are reflected in the infinity pool. The pool is aptly named as a swimmer within would certainly feel like there are no limits to possibility.



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APARTMENTS - Kilimani



The Kilimani Area of Nairobi is home to a number of noteworthy developments and this is soon to be counted among the ranks. The design approach allows the individual tenant the choice of how much to interact with the neighbour. Oriented round courtyards the apartment complex offers a communal centre, and yet provide each with private views out onto manicured, landscaped gardens.



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APARTMENTS - Kilileleshwa



Aiming to maximise the views out onto the Kirichwa Kubwa Riverside are these Three Bedroomed Duplex apartments each with an integrated Domestic Staff Quarter. This unit being an integral part of the house could easily function as a Study, or TV room. The double frontage to each apartment allows all Bedrooms save one to look onto the priceless view that is the Riverside.



APARTMENTS - Thompson Estate



On an acre in the Thompson Estate area of Nairobi we were commissioned to maximise the potential for a parcel of land where previously 4 No. Townhouses stood.

The solution offered created two courts around which the apartments overlooked.

The location of parking in the basement allows the ground level to be dedicated to greenery, a pleasant change from the common solution. The resulting absence of the concrete apron is immediately noticeable and appreciable.

Internally the apartments offer every convenience a family might seek. Fitted open kitchen, ensuite rooms, balconies overlooking the greens are all standard in the units.



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APARTMENTS - Karbasiran

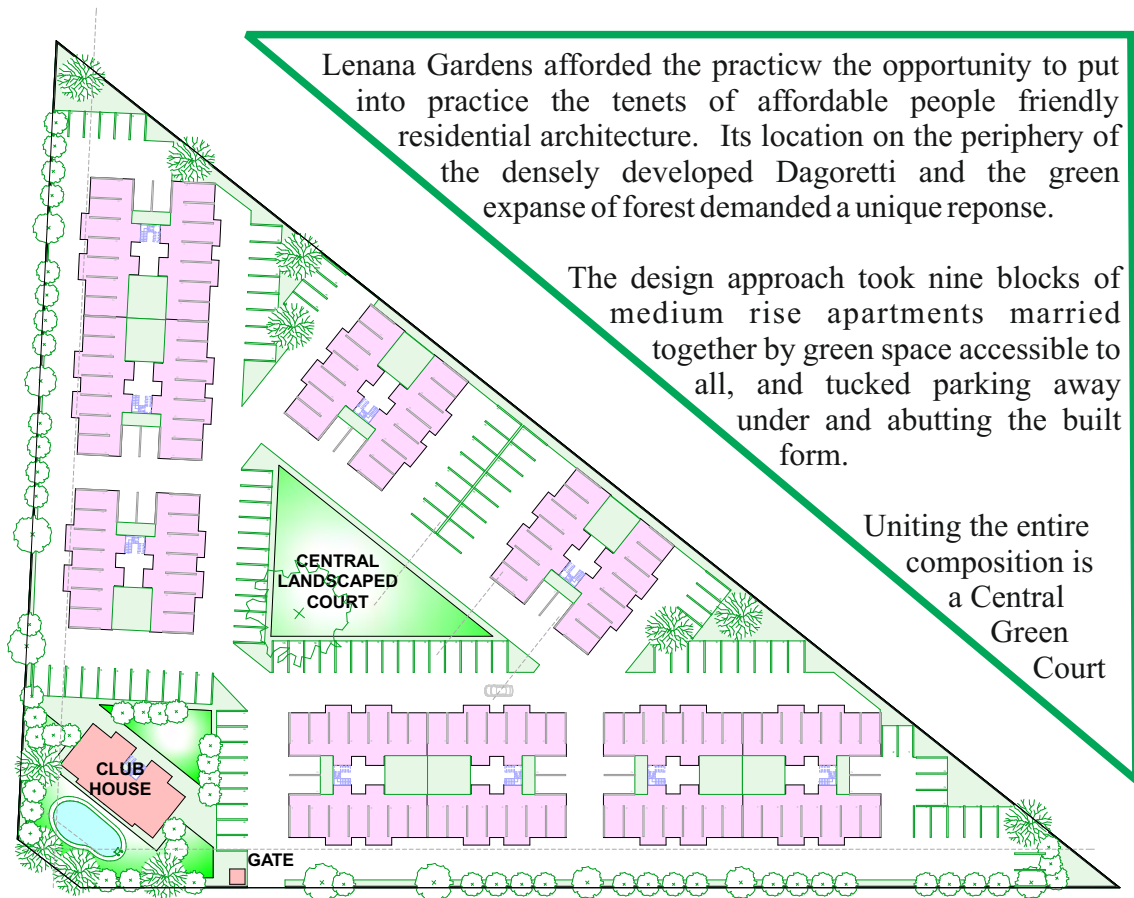


Located on Kayahwe Road, in the Kilimani area of Nairobi this proposal afforded twenty four, three-bedroomed apartments with staff quarters. Amenities provided included a controlled access with concierge services, common club and gym facilities as well as exquisitely landscaped gardens. The green space allowed in the development, in keeping with the leafy area the project is located in.



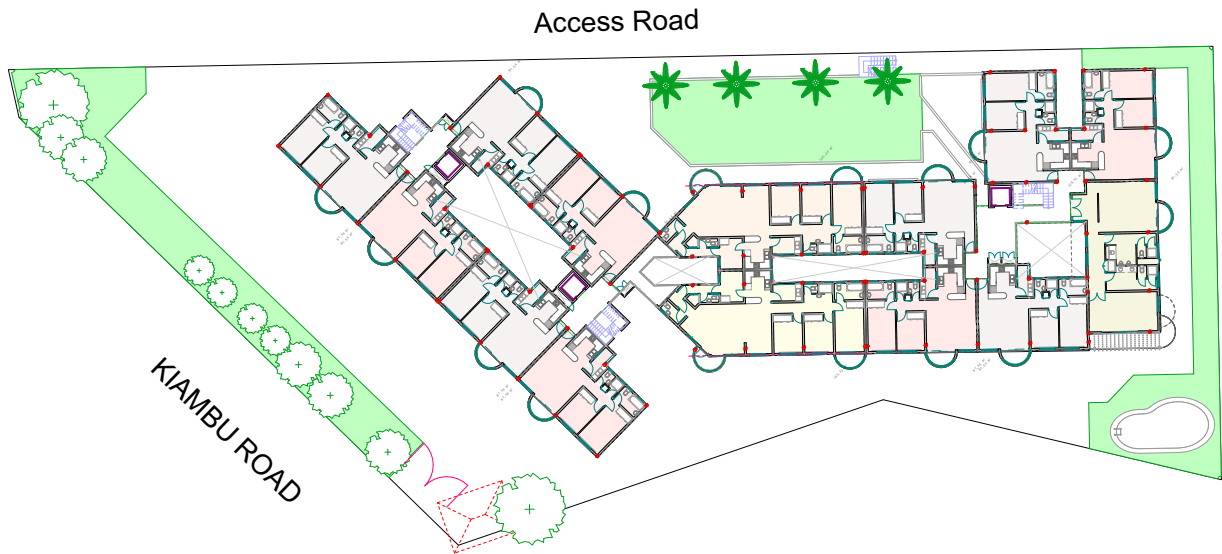
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LENANA GARDEN - Lenana

Located along Kiambu Rd, Runda Royale is an entry level apartment building for the young family looking for an attractive affordable abode.

This high density development boasts views onto Paradise Lost and the surrounding coffee farms, a view every one of the Eighty Three Apartments can lay claim to. Service spaces are oriented round a Central Ventilation void ensuring an external aspect to the living spaces of all apartments.

Its skewed orientation makes the best of site morphology while maximising on the use of the limited resource that is land.



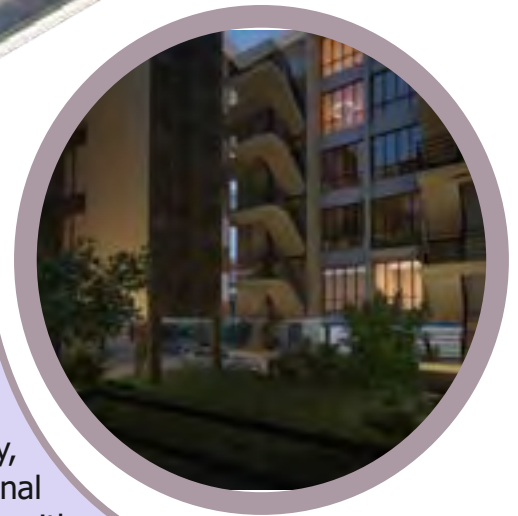
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MOWLEM HEIGHTS - Komarock



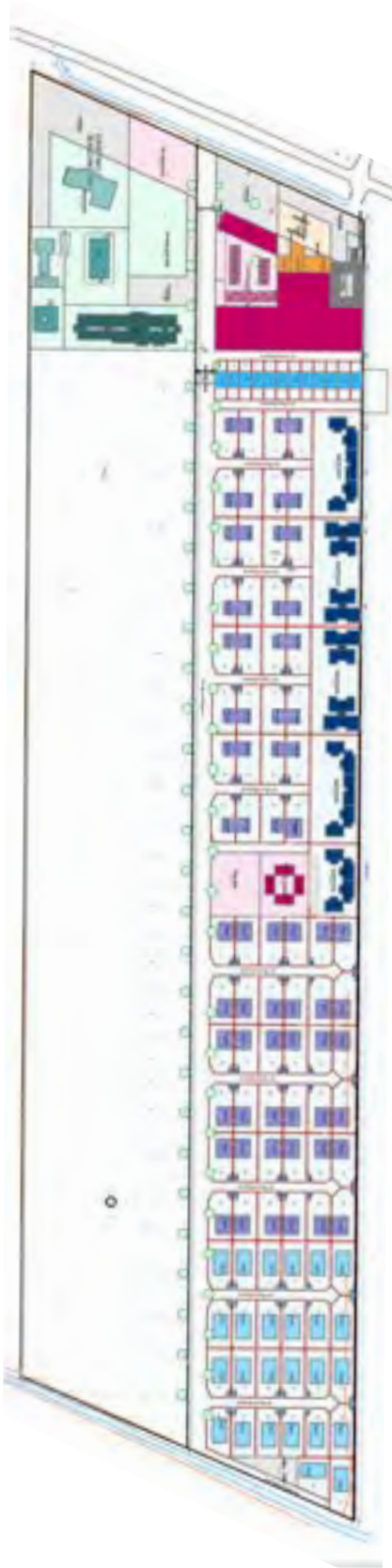
Revisiting the theme of creating livable spaces while satisfying the basic economic driver of maximising returns, Mowlem Heights is a departure from the norm in its setting.

The high density development allows each unit privacy, plenty of light and fosters community around internal courtyards. Basic amenities are well catered for along with some not-so-basic ones such as individual car parks, a community club house and recreation centre, as well as a commercial centre



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HOUSING ESTATE - Naivasha



Much of the floricultural produce for which Kenya is famed is produced along Moi South Lake Road in Naivasha. This road which runs along the Southern Shores of Lake Naivasha also is home to some of the best getaways for Nairobi based young urban professionals.

This development seeks to tap into the potential which this location holds for holiday homes and exploit the need for a commercial centre away from the commercial town centre of Naivasha. It provides for a variety of house sizes and types ranging from the One Bedroom Apartment to the Four Bedroom Townhouse for the permanent resident.



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KITISURU TERRACES -Kitisuru



An upmarket residential estate, Kitisuru Terraces harkens to the Tudor Style of house. With faux-beams of timber exposed externally, steeply pitched roof covered with clay tiles, and small pane casement windows, the ambience .

The distinctive homely design and layout in discrete groupings of four all add up to create a feeling of neighbourhood and community. This is reinforced by the low common fences and shared driveways.

Privacy is afforded by the terracing effected to respect the natural fall of the land. This inadvertently allows each dwelling its own piece of paradise.



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MALIBU GARDENS - Katani

Malibu Gardens is a comprehensive housing scheme situated in Katani in the outskirts of Nairobi, that comprises a total of two hundred and thirty seven residential units.



This major project was initiated by Windsor Homes Limited to accommodate the growing demand for attractive and economical family houses.

The estate is planned to create a secure neighbourhood with four spacious house types constructed to exacting standards of finishes. The community facilities include a nursery school, a social centre located strategically along the spine of the development, and a shopping centre with adjoining recreational facilities.

To provide visual relief and a sense of scale a combination of material finishes was used on external surfaces, with exposed stone to minimise the long-term maintenance requirements and colour variations in the paint work and roof tiles to differentiate successive clusters. Individual gardens and open spaces are also thoughtfully landscaped to create a pleasant environment.



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XANADU ESTATE - Athi River



In the Athi River area of Mavoko Council, which lies on the outskirts of Nairobi along the multi lane Mombasa Highway is this scheme which comprises One hundred and Twenty residential units along with commercial, and communal facilities.

The planning layout sought to create an attractive and functional layout, centered round green spaces. available for communal use. The scheme interspersed different house types to create a vibrant mix of tenancies all arranged in a logical framework to facilitate spatial comfort for the residents and visitors to the development.



AWING VILLAS - Thika



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NTUNGAMO HOUSE - Bukoba



In a picturesque setting commanding breathtaking views over the Lake Victoria is set Ntungamo House, a 17,000 square foot residence providing four self contained bedrooms, four living suites, and a two bedroomed guesthouse beside. Also provided is a poolhouse with a fully equipped gym and wellness centre.

Neo-classical in style, a simple formal arrangement of spaces within allows optimisation of views onto the lake from its clifftop position.

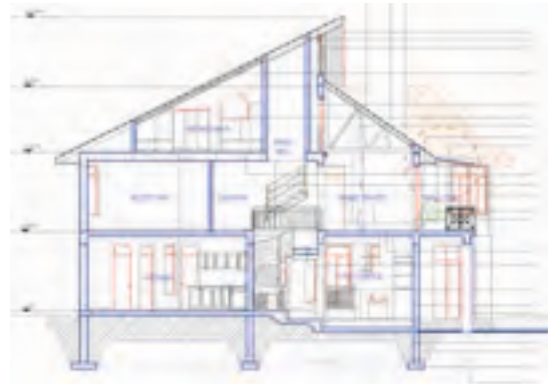
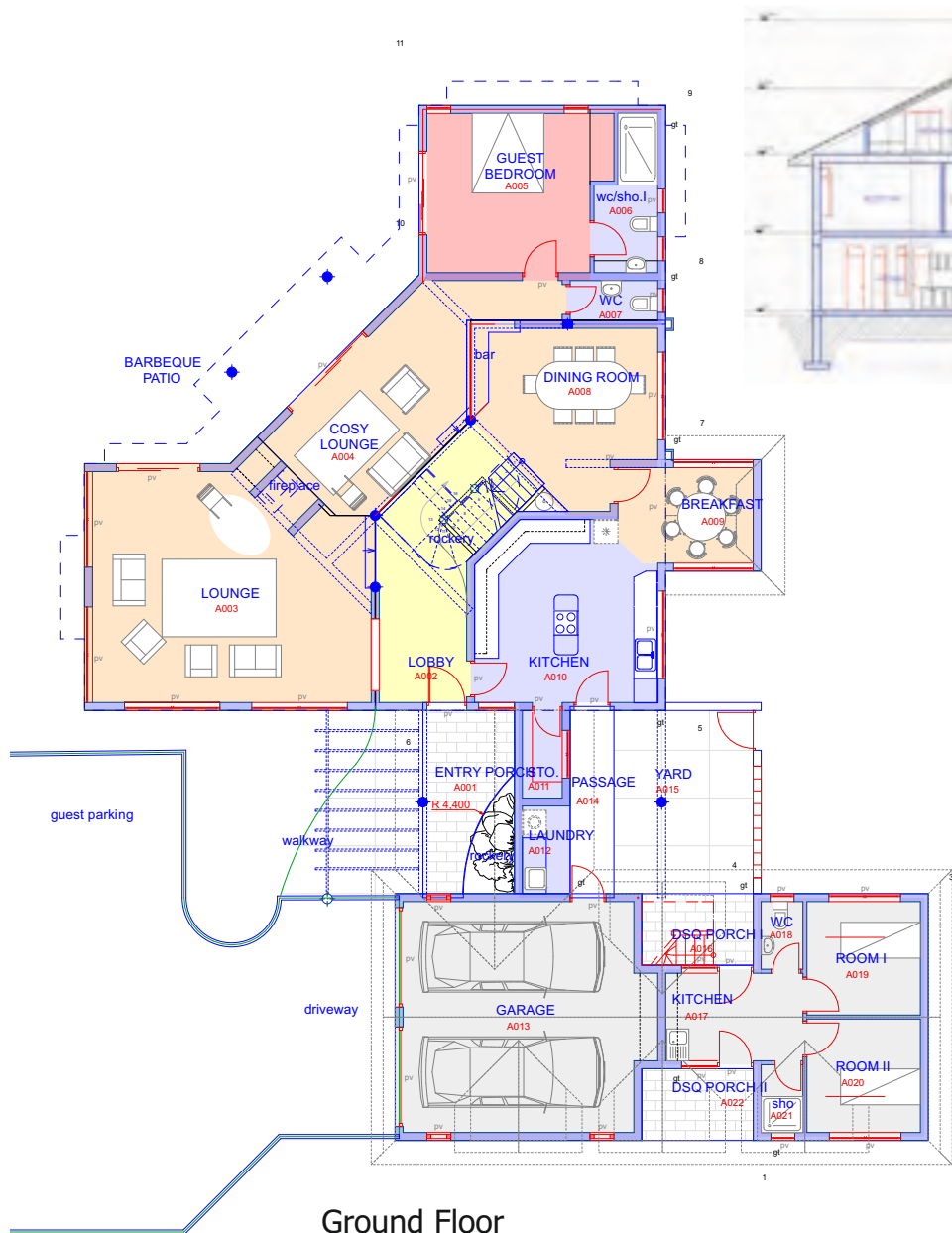


Ground Floor Layout
